Re: **Genesis Alkali Sodium Carbonate – Prop 65 Statement**

Dear Valued Customer:

Genesis has evaluated our product, sodium carbonate (all grades), for compliance with California's "Safe Drinking Water and Toxics Enforcement Act of 1986" (commonly referred to as Proposition 65). Several samples of various product grades were analyzed and compared to the latest Prop 65 chemical list. Based upon test results, we do not believe exposure to our sodium carbonate product poses a significant risk of causing cancer or reproductive toxicity. Nonetheless, we are notifying you that the following chemicals have been periodically detected in composite samples of our sodium carbonate products (all grades). This will assist you in evaluating your products and any obligations you may have under the law. Our product shown may contain the listed typical concentrations of Prop 65 chemicals, known to cause cancer (A) and/or reproductive toxicity (B).
